Camp Details:

Location: Allynbrooke Stables, 18241 SW Mt. Home Rd., Sherwood, OR 97140

Days: 4 days; Tuesday - Friday

Time: 8 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Before Camp:

- Send \$100 non-refundable deposit to hold your spots
- Fill out Liberty Reins Liability Release form if you have not already done so
 - www.libertyreins.com/lessons (form is at bottom of page)
- Think about getting proper footwear that is close-toed with at least a slight heel

Week of Camp:

- Pay remaining balance owed prior to first day of camp
- Bring liability release form with you or plan to have a parent/legal guardian fill one out the first day of camp
- Plan for what to bring:
 - Weather-appropriate clothing
 - Close-toed footwear is required and with at least a small heel is ideal
 - Layers (can be cooler in the morning)
 - Snacks
 - Water bottle
 - Gloves to keep hands clean while working if desired

What We Do:

Typical week of camp can include some or all of the following depending on the week.

Daily

- 1 hour lesson (minimum)
- Feeding horses
- Cleaning stalls
- Cleaning waters

Various

- Paddock cleaning
- Grounds cleaning
- Bathing horses - weather permitting (we try at least once each week)
- General barn clean-up
- Special projects
- Medical care of horses (only if needed and appropriate)
- Exercising horses (based on experience and only if safe to do so)
